- Play by the rules,

- Never argue with an official,
- Fair play means respect,
- Control your temper,
- Verbal abuse of officials, and sledging other players and deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent, are not acceptable or permitted,
- Be honest with the coach concerning illness and ability to train and compete to the best of your ability,
- Work equally hard for yourself and/or your team. You and your team's performance will benefit,
- A professional appearance relating to language, manner, temper, and punctuality is always to be adopted,
- Accept defeat with dignity. Nobody wins all the time. Learn to lose graciously. Do not seek excuses for defeat, genuine reasons will always be self-evident. Congratulate the winners with good grace. Do not blame the referee or anyone else. Good losers earn more respect than bad winners,
- Promote the interests of football/futsal, it is the world's greatest game. Think of football's interests before your own. Think how your actions may affect the image of the game. Talk about the positive things in the game. Be an ambassador for the game,
- Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor. Watch out for attempts to tempt you into cheating or using drugs. Drugs and alcohol are not permitted at the venue,
- Co-operate with your coach, team-mates, and opponents. Without them there would be no competition. They have the same rights as you have, including the right to be respected,
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please coaches and others. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
